

- → First department of the Barcelona City Council to carry out an internal "Strategic Sustainability Plan" (SSP)






The Strategic Sustainability Plan (SPP) 2013 - 2022

SPP, Purchasing and internal management




The structure of the SSP

B1.2.5. Purchasing of ammunition with low lead content (or lead free) for the City Police



The tender with environmental criteria (exclusion of lead and other heavy) metals) has been published (70.400 €)

B1.2.6. Achieve progress in incorporation of Compressed Air Foam Systems in Fire **Engines**



In 2014, 8 Compressed Air Foam Systems that achieve greater distances using less water and foam (60-70%) have been purchased







B.4.4.2. Establish a procedure for the reuse of work wear from the Fire Brigade.



Reuse of 383 unused firemen's shirts through a recovery company dedicated to labour integration

B5.1.3. Realize a pilot project with an electric van and check its functionality for the provision of internal messenger services (City Police)



After 1 month of testing → 170,5 Kg CO₂ & 213,70 € saved

B. Logistics | B6. Storage

B6.4.2. Establish a procedure to properly handle furniture from Fire Brigade at the end of its life cycle



Reuse of 27 chairs from indoor use to outdoor furniture (9.800 € saved) through a recovery company dedicated to labour integration












Monitoring the SPP progress

Key elements

- ✓ The Strategic Sustainability Plan is led by the PSM Management
- ✓ A progressive and participatory process
- ✓ A strategic approach (internal organization ← 13 internal interviews)
- ✓ With the involvement of all the actors (internal Monitoring Committee)
- ✓ With a different priorization of execution (high, medium and low)
- ✓ With indicators to regulary monitor progress
- ✓ Efforts to disseminate the SSP
